

KITE FISHING DRIFT

Drifting is the most popular approach to kite fishing, punctuated by surface strikes from aggressive game fish. Using two kites weighted to fly to the left and right, with multiple baits off each kite line to achieve maximum surface coverage. In fact, flat lines used on the upwind side of the boat provide even more coverage. A sea anchor(s) to slow the boat's drift can help the kite fly better.
